### Lord's Supper:

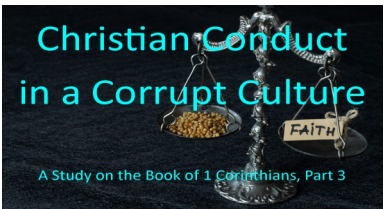
**Sunday, February 1st**, we will joyfully celebrate the **Lord's Supper** during the English Worship Service.
