Therefore, I hereby remise, release, acquit, satisfy, and forever discharge the said second party, of and from all and all manner of action and actions, cause and causes of action, suits, debts, dues, sums of money, accounts reckonings, bonds, bills, specialties, covenants, contracts, controversies, agreements, promises, variances, trespasses, damages, judgments, executions, claims and demands whatsoever, in law or in equity, by direct claim or by indemnification, which said first party ever had, now has, or which any personal representative, successor, heir or assign of said first party, hereafter can, shall or may have, against said second party, for upon or by reason of any matter, cause or thing whatsoever, from the beginning of the world to the day of these presents.

YOUTH VOLUNTEER RULES

(Detach from volunteer form and keep for your reference)

As a youth volunteer, I play a crucial role in guiding children to live with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, patience, endurance, forgiveness, and love. My conduct, therefore, mirrors that of Christ, underscoring the significance of my role in the church community.

To be an effective Christian role model, I agree to dress modestly and appropriately for our church setting and have the freedom to interact with the children no matter what activity they are involved in.

Our dress code is designed to ensure a respectful and appropriate environment for all. Modest and appropriate dress is defined as shorts or pants (no skirts) - length being mid-thigh or below (*short length must be no shorter than the tip of your finger when your arm is straight at your side*), not extremely tight, and no showing of buttocks, cheeks, or underwear when standing or bent over; if hip-hugging pants are worn, the shirt must overlap the top of the pants even when bending over. Shirts/blouses - must completely cover the chest, midriff, and stomach, be made of non-see-through fabric, and with no obscene or rude language and/or advertising, have sleeves or wide shoulder straps (*no tank tops or muscle shirts*).

Cell phones will be in the off or non-audible setting and only used in case of an emergency; this goes for text messaging as well!

The Vacation Bible School leadership staff reserves the right to ask anyone dressed or behaving inappropriately to leave their area of assignment and to call for a ride home. This is to maintain a safe and respectful environment for all participants.

I will be ready to help each day from June 8th through June 12th from 8:30 a.m. until 12:15 p.m. and **attend all required training and planning meetings and set-up (June 4th-6th) unless cleared with the VBS Director beforehand**. Unfortunately, students must be moved to a waiting list if this is not done. This waiting list is to ensure that all volunteers are committed and prepared for their roles.

Training meetings will be held at the church on **Saturday, May 16th, from 9:00 a.m. to noon and Friday, June 5th, from 7:00 to 8:00 p.m.**

All youth volunteers must be picked up by **12:30 p.m.** unless they are working with their assigned teacher(s).

While Riverside Baptist Church **is committed to accommodating** your preferences, it's important to understand that **placement is not guaranteed**. We value your contribution and will do our best to honor your requests.

It's important to note that space is limited, and placement decisions will be made only after the completed and signed form is returned to the church office or Vacation Bible School table on Sundays. This process ensures that all volunteers are considered fairly and transparently.

Youth volunteers start at completed 7th grade.

**Forms must be turned in to the church office no later than May 15, 2026.
Forms turned in to the church office after May 15th will be placed on a waiting list.**
