For those joining us from home, please have unsalted crackers and juice ready, so you can feel truly included and connected in this meaningful observance.

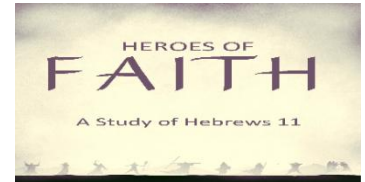
We also kindly ask you to remember that during the Lord's Supper, we collect for the Pastor's Discretionary Fund (PDF).
